INTRODUCTION

Kathmandu Model Hospital School of Nursing (KAMHSON) is a well-known and highly reputed institute in the field of nursing education, located in the capital city of Kathmandu. Established in 2058 B.S., KAMHSON boasts a glorious 23-year history in the field of nursing education. KAMHSON is an autonomous institute under the umbrella of Public Health Concern Trust, Nepal (pfect-NEPAL). The school is dedicated to nurturing technically competent and socially responsible nurses. KAMHSON has its own hospital, Kirtipur Hospital, which is a tertiary-level hospital and the country's first national burn center as well. KAMHSON runs two academic programs: Post-Basic Bachelor of Nursing Science (PBNS) and Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN), in affiliation with Purbanchal University.

Post Basic Bachelor of Nursing Science (PBNS)

The Post-Basic Bachelor of Nursing (PBNS) is a three-year course designed for registered nurses seeking to advance their education and skills. The program is affiliated with Purbanchal University (P.U.) and has been conducted since 2063 B.S. at KAMHSON. Since establishment, a total of 452 students (14 batches) have graduated in PBNS from KAMHSON. The course offers

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four major elective subjects to enable students to select their own interest in career development: Medical Surgical Nursing, Psychiatric Nursing, Midwifery, and Community Health Nursing.

Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)

It offers a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSc Nursing) program that focuses on providing a high-quality education in nursing. The program is affiliated with Purbanchal University (P.U.) and has been conducted since 2070 B.S. Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) is a four-year course that can be commenced after completing the Higher Secondary Level of Basic Science (Biology group) designed to combine basic and advanced levels of nursing knowledge and practice with the aim of preparing competent professional nurses to work in education, administrative, and service sectors. Since establishment, a total of 138 students (7 batches) have graduated with a BSN from KAMHSON.
